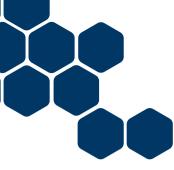

With consistent guidance and practical solutions like setting an alarm, Shellsea gradually adjusted to her routine. Over time, she began attending workshops fully awake, expressing her love for being part of our program. Her story highlights the positive impact of small, consistent changes in creating lasting growth.

"REACHING THE TOP!"

When **Ally** first came to the Foundation, she was shy and reluctant to get involved in any activities. She often avoided physical challenges, claiming they were too difficult for her. However, since becoming part of H2C, she has embraced new experiences, including rock climbing—something she had never tried before. During her first attempt, she didn't quite reach the top of the "mountain," but she didn't give up. On her most recent visit, Ally successfully completed the rock-climbing obstacle not just once, but five times!



"THE FEELING WAS UNLIKE ANYTHING ELSE-IT WAS SO FREEING!"

Julian joined H2C, sharing that he felt isolated and without purpose. Throughout the program, he earned his IT Fundamentals Certification from CompTIA, began attending workshops and became a regular at the weekly chess club. A turning point came during a scuba diving event. Initially hesitant, Julian overcame his fear of water, experiencing the freeing sensation of immersion for the first time. His triumph brought tears of joy to everyone, symbolizing the transformative power of support and encouragement.



Highlights

In October 2023, the Dan Marino Foundation launched **HUB2CONNECT**, designed to support individuals with autism. Members attended 598 sessions, covering 211 topics with over 4,400 bookings. Workshops focused on life skills, financial independence, and career readiness, delivering an average satisfaction of 3.7 out of 4 stars. Since its initiation, membership has surged by over 300%, all metrics reflecting the high quality services you've helped make possible.

In Spring 2024, the Foundation relocated to Dania Beach. Working with the city's officials and a grant from the Miami Dolphins, the Foundation established the Autism Coalition of Inclusion, Acceptance, and Equity (ACE) to foster inclusion, acceptance, and equity for individuals with autism. ACE is a collaboration among businesses, sports teams, first responders, schools, and government agencies designed to raise awareness, promote independence, and advocate for equitable opportunities in education, employment, and recreation.

To promote acceptance of individuals with autism, the Foundation hosted the **Dan Marino Foundation Autism Family Sunday** at Dania Pointe in April 2024, celebrating Autism Acceptance and Awareness Month. Over 1,500 children and families enjoyed autism-friendly activities featuring entertainers, sports teams, and first responders, along with a Resource Marketplace that offered valuable information for families.

The Foundation continues to cultivate and engage with **donors**, legacy supporters, and corporate partners, to secure funding, thanks to the ongoing generosity of organizations like Badia Spices, UKG, Scherr Family Foundation, Emeril Lagasse Foundation, Walgreens, Payton Nash Foundation, Anthony's Runway 84, Midwest Air Traffic Control, North Fort Lauderdale Subaru, the Miami Dolphins, Dania Pointe, and the NFL Foundation.
